Dr. Kay Phillips Administrator-of-the-Year Award

To receive SIPA's Administrator of the Year Award, a candidate must the following criteria:

- The administrator must provide support to more than one publication.
- The administrator must nurture the principles of scholastic journalism.
- The administrator must provide support, both in time and in aiding the acquisition of the needs of the journalism program.
- The administrator must recognize the time demands placed upon the adviser for publications.
- The administrator must support the professional growth of the adviser.
- The administrator must support the educational growth of the students by encouraging them to attend seminars.
- The administrator must support the academic standards of the courses and the enrollment of students therein.
- The administrator must support publications' participation in the memberships and critiques of state, regional, and national organizations.
- At least one publication at the administrator's school must be an active member of SIPA. SIPA advisers may nominate the administrators at their schools.

The application must provide specific information about the administrator's support, as outlined in the criteria listed above. The nominating adviser of the winning administrator will be notified prior to the convention.

Winners should be present at the convention to receive the award and to comment briefly about their support of scholastic journalism.
